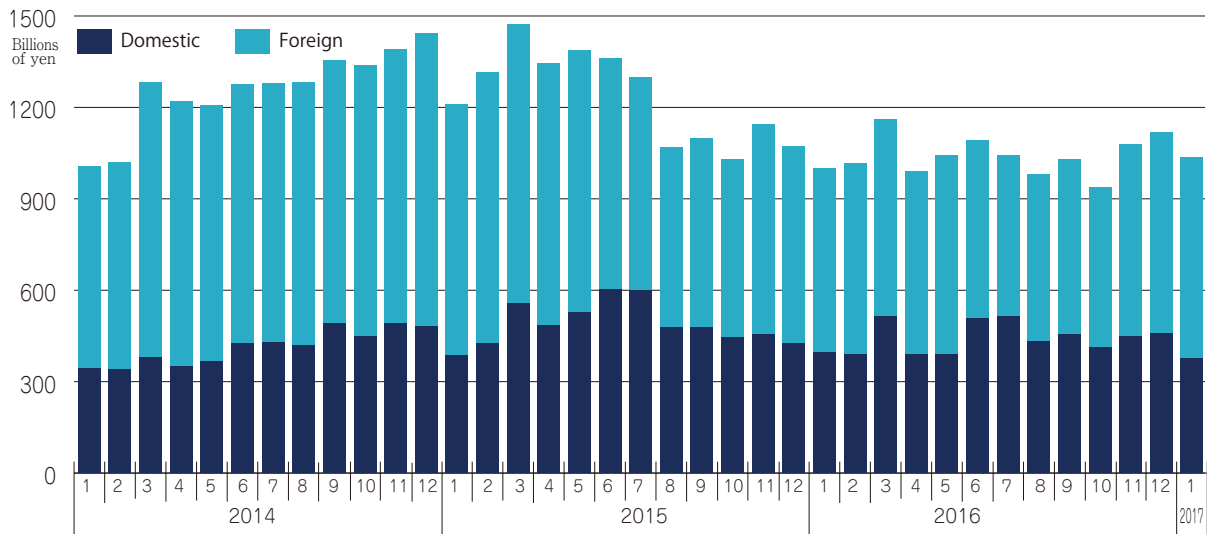

Domestic order: under 40 billion yen for the first time in 8 months

On February 16th, 2017, Japan Machine Tool Builders' Association announced that the total value of machine tool order in January decreased by 7.3% from the last month to 103.7 billion yen. This was over 100 billion yen for 3 consecutive months. This figure represented an increase of 3.5% compared to the last month of the previous year and an increase of 2 consecutive months.

Domestic order fell by 17.9% from the last month to 37.7 billion yen. This was a decrease of 4.6% compared to the last month of the previous year. This was over 40 billion yen for the first time in 8 months.

Foreign order rose by 0.1% from the last month to 65.9 billion yen. This was over 65 billion yen for 2 consecutive months. This figure also represented an increase of 8.7% from the last month to the previous year and was an increase of 2 consecutive months.
